HCPL Film This! Book Trailers Rules & Information

This contest is open to all teens in grades 6-12. Contestants are asked to create an entirely original book trailer of their book of choice and post to YouTube. A cash grand prize will be awarded to the winning entry and be divided among the creators of the book trailer. Second Place and Third Place will receive a cash prize as well. ALL PRIZES will be divided among the creators of the winning book trailers. Staff are not eligible for this contest.

- 1) Book Trailers are to be no more than 2 minutes in length. Any entries submitted over 2 minutes in length will lose points and may not be shown.
- 2) Only original or stock music is to be used. Do not use any music that requires a license or royalty. Use of licensed music will result in a lower overall score, and a disqualification of your video. To find free stock music, type "free stock music" in a search engine like Google or Yahoo! Some sites include: sampleswap.org, freesoundtrackmusic.com, freemusicarchive.org, and freestockmusic.com.
- 3) No inappropriate language or images are to be used. Any trailer that includes inappropriate language or images will not be accepted.
- 4) Post your video on YouTube under the title of "HCPL Film This! 2020 (Name of Your Book)". Once you post your video under this title, please email us at filmthis@hcplonline.org. In your email, attach a copy of the Credits page, which can be found here – <u>http://hcplonline.org/filmthis.php</u>
- 5) Complete a registration form and hand in to your local librarian. Your video will not be accepted until we have received the credits page and registration form.
- 6) FINAL ENTRY DEADLINE: ENTRIES MUST BE POSTED TO YOUTUBE BY FEBRUARY 15, 2020!
