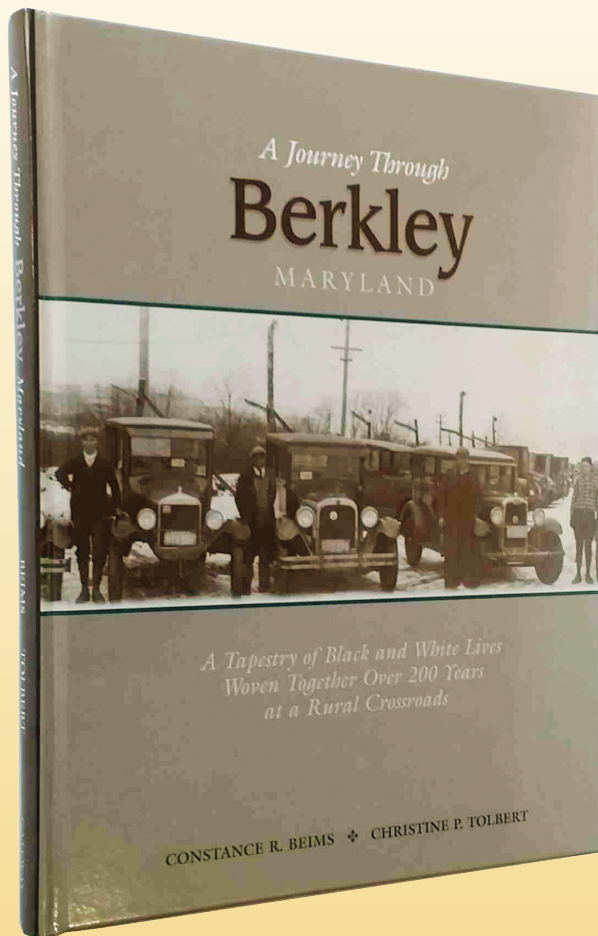


CELEBRATE BLACK HISTORY MONTH
